

The Board hopes everyone has been enjoying the past few weeks at the Pool! We appreciate that most members are complying with the documentation, face covering, and distancing requirements mandated by the State and County. Compliance with these rules is important to maintaining the Pool's ability to keep its license and stay open. Please take time to include first and last names on the health assessment form. Accurate forms allow us to avoid restricting pool visits to scheduled reservations.

The Board has been actively looking at ways to revise the rules to allow for more flexibility while staying within the confines of the current State/County requirements. To that end, we would like to announce the following changes effective Monday, June 29:

- Members 12 years old and older may attend without a parent consistent with the normal Rollingwood rules as long as they have a health assessment/waiver form SIGNED BY A PARENT and their Pool ID. Please remind your children of the mask and social distancing rules. Parents will be contacted if their children fail to follow the rules.
- Guests and non-swimming grandparents are still not permitted at this time. Nanny passes are available for \$125 with prior approval of the Board. A nanny pass allows a "nanny" or other adult to attend with children when a parent is not present. A nanny pass cannot be used for entrance to the Pool when an adult member is present. Contact the Treasurer for more information on a nanny pass.
- Out-of-town houseguest passes are available with prior approval of the Board for \$25 (individual) or \$45 (family) per week. Houseguest passes can be used for long-term houseguests with appropriate documentation. Contact the Treasurer for more information on a houseguest pass.
- These rule revisions will be reflected on the Rollingwood website in the next few days. We also will be posting a Frequently Asked Questions document to address some of the feedback we have been receiving from members. We also are looking at other ways to maximize your Pool experience such as allowing use of picnic tables and opening the grills.
