

Dear Members,

Opening Day, June 17th, is less than a week away! Given the increased allowed capacity under the Governor's new directive, as adopted by Baltimore County, pending any restrictions under the latest Department of Health regulations, we are altering our plan and not using a scheduling calendar at the start of this season. Please look for the complete rules/policies on the pool's website, rollingwoodpool.org, on Sunday. Here are a couple of important notes:

1. Pool ID cards – Because we are no longer using the planned scheduling calendar, it is important that all members have their ID cards in order to enter the pool. No one will be permitted to come in without their card. Please take time now to locate your pool ID. If you cannot find your pool ID, please contact Bill Protzman at webmaster@rollingwoodpool.org.
2. Members will be required to complete a waiver/health assessment each time they visit the pool. Every person in the family coming to the pool will need their own form. The waiver/health assessment will be available to download on the website. Bringing completed forms to the pool will greatly decrease the time required for entering the pool.
3. The increased capacity allowed under the Governor's directive applies to the facility. Members must still socially distance from other households both on the grounds and in the water. As our grounds are larger than our pool, there may be times the staff must limit the number of people in the water at a given time.
4. If we find there is too much demand for even the new expanded capacity or if members do not comply with social distancing requirements, we will revert back to the originally planned reservation system. This could significantly reduce members' pool time, so we ask that everyone please cooperate with social distancing and other new rules.
